
2017 Diebold Federal Credit Union Scholarship Program

Scholarship Criteria and Eligibility

The DFCU scholarship is a one-time scholarship to be awarded in 2017. It may be offered again in subsequent years based on the availability of funds. To qualify for a one-time scholarship, an applicant must be at least a high school senior and in pursuit of post-secondary education of any kind, including professional, vocational, and academic studies not limited to colleges and universities.

To ensure anonymity and fairness, scholarship applications will be reviewed by an outside, independent selection committee which will carefully review each application and award the scholarship(s) to the most deserving applicant.

The DFCU scholarship will be advertised on the DFCU web site, via flyers and posters at both office locations, and through guidance counselors at area high schools, colleges and universities.

Diebold Federal Credit Union employees, board members and committee members and their family members are eligible for scholarship opportunities. Scholarship applicant must be a member of the Diebold Federal Credit Union and at least a senior in high school.

The scholarship(s) will be awarded in May 2017 with applications submitted to the Diebold Federal Credit Union, Attn: CEO, 6299 Dressler Rd., Canton, OH 44720 no later than April 30, 2017.
